SELF-ADMINISTRATION OF ASTHMA MEDICATION AUTHORIZATION FORM

According to the Illinois School Code, students are allowed to self-administer a prescribed quick reliever asthma inhaler while in school, while at a school-sponsored activity, while under the supervision of school personnel, or before or after normal school activities, such as while in before-school or after-school care, and on school-operated property. The following regulations must be met:

- School authorities are provided a prescription label that must contain the name of the medication, the prescribed dosage, and the time at which or circumstances under which the medication is to be administered.
- Parents or guardians must provide written authorization for the self-administration of a quick reliever asthma inhaler.
- Written authorization from parents or guardians for the self-administration of a quick reliever asthma inhaler and current prescription label must be updated each school year, or as changes in medication or health status indicate.
